### NAIMS - Imaging Repository

Since its launch in summer 2022:

- Seven sites are actively using NAIMS-IR to support their research projects.
- Approximately 672 DICOM scans have been uploaded from 552 participants.

Our repository supports DICOM, PARREC, and NIfTI upload and download with a user friendly search/filter query. Users are able to upload and download the clinical data associated with the scans (csv and excel format).








### NAIMS Symposium at the 2024 ACTRIMS Forum
